PLEASE NOTE:

GENERAL NOTES:

- All soil movements should take place during dry weather (when topsoil is not wet).
- Topsoil should be stripped first & stored separately from subsoil.
- All topsoil to be good quality/medium loam and free from deleterious material.
- Organic matter to be added when necessary to create a good friable structure.
- Soil depth for trees 1000mm (40% free draining subsoil, 60% topsoil) for general planting 700mm.
- All grass levels to be raised 100mm above kerb level.
- All landscape treatment subject to engineer's approval for structural, moisture and drainage considerations.
- Gravel or hard surface like between all planting and buildings, approx width 300mm.
- For high back shelter fencing should be erected for the first two seasons in wind vulnerable areas.
- Bank mesh cross to 50mm depth should be added to all ornamental planting and replanted annually to maintain depth.

TREES & SHRUBS (PLANTING, CARE & MAINTENANCE):

- Trees to be supported by staking depending on size.
- 1.4-1.5m trees planted in prepared tree pits, 900 x 900 x 1000mm. Secured with double stake and cross bar.
- 15-18 cm girth - Secured with double stake and cross bar, avoiding periods of frost, water logging or drought.
- Bare root trees to be planted in the period of Nov-March.
- Shelter fencing to be erected during establishment phase.

MAINTENANCE:

- Weed control by residual chemical and by regular spot treatment with translocatable (e.g. Glyphosate) during the growing season. Weeds among plants to be hand weeded where necessary.
- Pruning of all plants to be carried out by a competent horticulturist in accordance with good practice.
- Watering: all planting to be kept well watered during dry weather especially during establishment phase.

- BED 1 & BED 2** Mixed Ornamental Planting Small to medium shrubs planting with pockets of perennial planting.
- BED 3** Low Groundcover Planting along gabions
- BED 4** Ornamental Planting with Year round interest in bark/much. Small to medium shrubs and perennials planting in drifts to create seasonal interest
- BED 5** Raised wall - Ornamental planting with year round interest. Low shrub and perennial planting
- BED 6** Low Ornamental planting in Gravel mulch Low shrub/ground cover/Alpine Planting with Perennials
- Hedge Planting**
- H1 Existing Hedge** Mixed Hedge mainly Laurel to be retained.
- H2 Proposed Hedge** Proposed Prunus (Laurel) to fill gap at front boundary.
- H3 Proposed Hedge** Proposed Prunus 'Etna' (Laurel) in gravel mulch along front boundary & car parking
- H4 Proposed Hedge** Proposed Hedge along rear boundary to replace Leylandii
- H5 Existing Hedge** Existing Hedge (Escallonia) to be retained and made good where required.
- Tarmac area** [existing]
- Concrete path** [existing]
- Proposed Paving** 1.8m width Path
- Resin Bond Surface**
- Lawn**
